Cant believe its been a week since i emailed last its ridiculous! This week hasn't been the most amazing week i have to say!!! I woke up Monday morning and pretty much had to stay on bed until Thursday afternoon!:-S

I have now had my turn in the sick bed! Monday morning i soon got a temperature and felt awful so crawled into bed while the others went out into town. My energy levels were at rock bottom most of the week as I didn't eat anything bar the odd piece of toast in 3 days. We resorted to antibiotics on Wednesday and my tummy decided it didnt want them so gave them back again! Anyway Thursday afternoon i managed to go for a coffee with the group (not that i had coffee but it meant i was out of the house!!) My sick feeling has just about gone now and im almost eating normally. I have one day of antibiotics left and when that's over i should be properly on the mend!! So yeh that has been my week! Lots of rest!!!

On Thursday morning the others went out with Anthony to give out tracts around the church and talk to people so hopefully they've sown a seed for a few people. We shall see. I think this Thursday we are going to do open air work in the main Plaza so please pray that that all goes well. If its not this thurs it will be the week after i should think.

The week ahead is going to be really busy but im really looking forward to it. Tomorrow morning we are off to Cusco to see the Colca Canyon which should be spectacular. Please pray that i have enough energy to walk at an even higher altitude than here and enjoy it! Walking to the shop yesterday knackered me out completely and its only 10minutes down the road! I'm struggling to get my energy back I think it must be the altitude as that tires you out anyway for the 1st 6months apparently!

On Wednesday we are heading to the new orphanage to finish off. Weve decided it will look nice with a border of rocks around it instead of broken bricks so i will need energy for that too - as will we all!

As i mentioned i think its open air Thursday and then on Friday me and Megan are going with a few people from the language institute to Puno to see Lake Titicaca. This is even higher again! but should be amazing!! We are getting a bus there so please pray we arrive safely with no break downs etc. The bus may be very nice we never know!! haha! So that is my week next week.

Also could you pray for Megan this week as she is thinking about returning to Peru in the future. Since we arrived she has become very attached to the place and the work here. The new orphanage is looking for volunteers to help run it and Megan is going to chat to Jose about it this week. Just pray that God would lead that conversation and ultimately lead Megan as to where He wants her to be.
