Anyway! last week we finished school which was quite sad, we made so many good friends there and it was strange saying goodbye to people when we still had 8 weeks left! The teachers got us a big chocolate fudge cake to say bye so we shared it with them and our new Swiss friends! and we had to say a few words in Spanish about our time which was k!!!

i dont know whether i have mentioned this but we have discovered a massive new shopping centre which i love!!! we went there in search of Cadburys chocolate but it is the equivalent of 5pounds (the pound sign isnt on this keyboard!!!!)! so yeh i have gone without cadburys! lol!

it would be good to pray for the ongoing work of our language school. It is run by a Christian family and they have taught many a missionary to speak Spanish - it would be good for that work to continue. Many of the people we met are off to work on the jungles of Peru - the Swiss couple i mentioned before are replacing another couple for 6 months out in the jungle so prayer for the work there in the poorer communities would be good plus for strength for the missionaries its hard work especially in terms of language!

As i mentioned this week was camp! Me and Megan are all depressed now it's over we had such a fab time! even though i found i was allergic to the mosquitoes at the coast so i swelled up! you should have seen my face - my eye was all puffed up i looked awful! lol! not attractive! lol!

we had a big walled area on the beach which was 5mins walk from the beach! to be honest our room was like a prison but thankfully we got our own room upstairs - downstairs it was 12 to a room!!!, the wind blew in all the dirt so literally everything was filthy, our beds were broken wood and the thin mattresses were too big for the bed! when you're trying to fit them on a bottom bunk its not that helpful! one day we had no water! the showers were freezing cold and dribbled at you! the loos had cracked seats, didn't flush and had doors that didn't shut! so basically we have been living in luxury!!! i loved it though it wasn't so bad!! - nan i thought of you every night when i has to go to bed with filthy feet and wrap myself in a cocoon by the way as well to stop myself getting bitten - nearly suffocated from repellant several times!!!! hehe!

there where about 90 people on camp a lot of whom don't come to church. Everyone seemed to enjoy themselves and get involved especially in the team games (my team won by the way Rita got very involved (for those of you who know what that means!))We formed an almost community, oh and there was a mini sermon every morning so hopefully some of the people will head along to the church. The kids especially as there aren't that many. Well teenagers mainly. i was talking to the pastor's son and he said that he doesn't like coming that much as there is no one his age - he is 16. I think a lot of the lads we spoke to at camp feel the same so prayer for the youth and non Christians at camp is another area of need.

I'm not sure what were up to this week we are in the hands of Anthony now. Continued prayer for the usual health and what not would be appreciated and I will email again God willing next week!
